## Readers Spreads VS. Printers Spreads

Readers spreads show consecutive pages in two page spreads.
They are in the correct order for someone to read the document.
Printer spreads are not in consecutive page order, they are in proper order so that when the document is printed, trimmed, assembled all the pages appear consecutively.


Helpful Hints: Odd page numbers are always on the right. The page numbers when added togethers should equal 1 number more than the total page count. For example for an 8 page book printers spreads are 8 \& $1=9,2 \& 7=9,3 \& 6=9,4 \& 5=9$
